Eligibility

Description of Proposed Works, Impacts and Risks

Please describe the proposed development, including the siting and location of the building(s)

The development proposed is for conversion of an existing agricultural farm building to form a new dwellinghouse. The subject building is located within the curtilage of The New Gables Nursery and is in sound structural condition (see planning statement). The building has an open aspect to the east, looking onto arable fields, and has adequate space around it to accommodate parking and servicing. The building also benefits from a long standing access to New Fen Drove and there are no other domestic buildings within the immediate proximity whereby nuisance or conflict could arise.

The purpose of the conversion is for succession in the management of the farm and the proposed dwelling would be occupied by the owners son and daughter in law, as they prepare to take over the day to day running of the business.

There is an indicative layout plan and proposed elevations included with this application which show that the proposed design includes a significant level of glazing, which will ensure that there is adequate light to all habitable rooms.

In line with Class Q guidance, the proposed extension will be single storey, built on an existing hardstanding, less than 4 metres (3.75m) and at the rear of the building to be converted. The location of the building means that there is no scope for the proposed extension to impact on the amenity of adjoining premises.

Indicative layout and elevation plans are included with this application. However, given that the applicant is the owner of the farm, and the conversion will be home to his son and daughter in law, the family will ensure that the design and materials used as part of the conversion are high quality, reflective of and complementary to the local vernacular and blend into the landscape.

As shown in the Design and Access Statement which accompanies this application, access to and from the proposed new dwelling is provided via an established link with New Fen Drove which has provided access to the existing barn, the flower nurseries and the arable land since at least 1963.

Given the location of the application building and its proposed change of use from storage of agricultural equipment and other machinery to a domestic dwelling, there will be no adverse noise impacts arising from this application.

There is no evidence or record of materials or chemicals being stored in the building which would have the potential to cause contamination. Equally, the surrounding land uses and landform are such that it is very unlikely that the building has been impacted by leachates of any kind.
