 - (a) Hawthorn (*Crataegus Monoyna*)
 - (b) Beech (*Fagus Sylvatica*)
 - (c) Blackthorn (*Prunus Spinosa*)
 - (d) Buckthorn (*Rhamnos Cathartica*)
- B - SILVER BIRCH (*Betula Pendula*) - Feathered
- C - ROWAN (*Sorbus*) - Feathered
- D - FLOWERING LAWNS Seeded EL -I Mix From Emorsgate Seeds
- E - Lincolnshire Wooden Post & Rail Fence
- F - 1.8m High Wooden Close Boarded Fence
- G - Gravel Driveway & Vehicle Parking
- H - Mixed Shrubs
 - 1) SPINDLE - 'CANADALE GOLD' - *Euonymus Fortunei*
 - 2) MEXICAN ORANGE BLOSSOM - *Choisya Ternata*
 - 3) ZEBRA PLANT - *Calathea Zebrina*
 - 4) FOXTAIL FERN - 'MYERSII' - *Asparagus Densiflorus*
- J - FLOWERING CHERRY - *Prunus 'Accolade'* - Feathered
- K - CRAB APPLE (*Malus Sylvestris*) - Feathered
- L - WILD CHERRY (*Prunus Avium*) - Feathered

Planting of Hedge to be double row staggered. Distance between plants to be 300mm.

- Distance between rows to be 450mm. All as specified by The Woodland Trust.
- All planting to be in accordance with BS 4428:1989 and amendment No. 1 (1991)
- All trees to be planted with minimum 0.6m plastic mulch mat and to be staked, tied and tubed.
