The Environment Agency hazard mapping shows that the site has a future hazard classification of 'Danger to Most' and could experience flood depths of 0.5-1m arising from a breach in the defences during a flood that has a 0.1% chance of occurring in any one year up to 2115.

The proposal therefore comes under cell D8 of the local flood risk standing advice and does not appear to fit any other criteria on our consultation checklist, 'When to consult the Environment Agency'.

Please consider the proposal against the guidance of the standing advice. We do not need to be consulted further on this application.
