Site to have soakaway testing, however for this Strategy we have assumed minimal infiltration due to the presence of existing water structure surrounding the site.

Highways Swales will have adoptable carrier pipes with the road drainage entering the carrier drainage and the hardstanding and roads entering swale via a filter strip providing treatment and storage.

Permeable Paving allow the treatment of roofs, hardstanding and private roads. This allows storage treatment and enables the discharge point to be restricted with a flow control devices.

Surface Water Carrier pipe network allows the conveyance of stormwater underground to the pond.
