Dear South Holland District Council,

I am writing with reference to your Invalid Application letter, requesting that we further explain our exemption to the Biodiversity Gain Condition.

The proposed development falls within the 'Development subject to the de minimis exemption (development below the threshold)', as it is stated in the Biodiversity Net Gain Guidance:

*"Development subject to the de minimis exemption. Development that does not impact a priority habitat and impacts less than 25 square metres (e.g. 5m by 5m) of onsite habitat, or 5 metres of linear habitats such as hedgerows."* - Paragraph: 003 Reference ID: 74-003-20240214

Our development measures 24m<sup>2</sup> and will not result in any linear habitat loss, therefore falling within these parameters. The red line boundary for this project measures at 89m<sup>2</sup>, however not all of this space will be used and simply allows us to have a small amount of extra space during construction.
