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## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 This Travel Plan has been prepared by Bancroft Consulting who were appointed by Country Court Care Homes to provide highways and transport advice in respect of the extension to its existing Ashwood Care Home facility at Spalding in Lincolnshire. This report follows South Holland District Council's decision to grant planning permission for the extension and reconfigured access/parking area under its Application Reference: H16-0437-24, dated 9<sup>th</sup> December 2024. Condition 14 of the corresponding Decision Notice stated:

14 Prior to occupation of the extension, a Travel Plan shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority in consultation with the Local Highway Authority. Those parts of the approved Travel Plan that are identified therein as being capable of implementation after occupation shall be implemented in accordance with the timetable contained therein and shall continue to be implemented for as long as any part of the development is occupied.

Reason: In order that the Local Planning Authority conforms to the requirements of the National Planning Policy Framework, a Travel Plan has been conditioned to ensure that access to the site is sustainable and reduces dependency on the car.

This Condition is imposed in accordance with Policies 2, 3, and 36 of the South East Lincolnshire Local Plan, 2019 and Section 14 of the National Planning Policy Framework, December 2023.

1.2 **Figure 1** shows the site location at the eastern edge of Spalding Common (B1172), approximately 3 kilometres south of Spalding in Lincolnshire.

1.3 This Travel Plan has been prepared in accordance with Lincolnshire County Council's Guidance Notes 'For the preparation and implementation of Development Travel Plans' (V5, December 2021). These guidance notes have been prepared in accordance with National Planning Guidance documents, where according to the document 'Travel Plans, Transport Assessments and Statements' (DfT, March 2014), Travel Plans are:

*"long-term management strategies for integrating proposals for sustainable travel into the planning process. They are based on evidence of the anticipated transport impacts of development and set measures to promote and encourage sustainable travel (such as promoting walking and cycling). They should not, however, be used as an excuse for unfairly penalising drivers and cutting provision for cars*



*in a way that is unsustainable and could have negative impacts on the surrounding streets.”*

(Paragraph 003, Travel Plans, Transport Assessments and Statements, MHCLG, March 2014)

1.4 The National Planning Guidance document also describes the primary purpose of a Travel Plan:

*"The primary purpose of a Travel Plan is to identify opportunities for the effective promotion and delivery of sustainable transport initiatives e.g. walking, cycling, public transport and tele-commuting, in connection with both proposed and existing developments and through this to thereby reduce the demand for travel by less sustainable modes. As noted above, though, they should not be used as a way of unfairly penalising drivers."*

(Paragraph 005, Travel Plans, Transport Assessments and Statements, MHCLG, March 2014)

1.5 The existing care home comprises 47 bed spaces and is served by approximately 20 car parking spaces. The consented scheme would increase this to 66 bed spaces and 28 car parking spaces. An extract of the approved site layout plan is provided below at **Image 1.5**.



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1.6 The care home would be operated by Country Court Care Homes, which is a well-established company that has many successful care homes throughout the country.

1.7 The new care home would be served by a reconfigured access arrangement with the main car parking area served directly from Petrel Drive, comprising a 6 metres carriageway and control radii. The access road then extends to serve a total of 20 car parking spaces and a bin store, with a further 8 spaces located in a western area that are served directly from the existing access at Spalding Common. A continuous footway extends along the western, northern and eastern edges of the site. Provision for 6 cycle parking spaces will also be made at the site.



## 2.0 SCOPE OF THE TRAVEL PLAN

2.1 This will be a simple extension of the existing care home facilities with associated staff and visitor activity. In receiving planning consent, the scheme was considered to represent sustainable development with appropriate opportunities for access by a reasonable choice of modes.

2.2 Using generic survey data for similar uses, it has been predicted that the proposed increase from 47 to 66 bed spaces (19 in total) would increase network peak hour traffic generation from 5 two-way movements to 8. During the inter-peak periods this would increase from 12 to 17 two-way movements. It is also expected that the overall development would generate a peak parking demand of 17 cars within the allocated areas. The following estimated modal split and corresponding peak hourly trip generation for the site (overall 66 beds) is based on comparable generic survey data for this use-type and size.

2.3 The key generator of hourly movements will be car-based activity, with up to 17 two-way hourly movements during the day. This will comprise a mixture of staff and visitor activity. This level of activity is not considered to be significant and should not present a material change in the existing operation. The consented car parking provision would also be sufficient to accommodate the predicted demand profile.

2.4 The care home is located east of the B1172 (Spalding Common) in Lincolnshire. It is adjacent to a new residential housing development and bound by the B1172 to



the west and undeveloped fields to the south. Spalding Town Centre is located approximately 3.6 kilometres northeast of the site.

- 2.5 In the immediate vicinity of the site, the B1172 extends in a north-to-south direction and is subject to 50mph speed limit restrictions. This is one of the main routes into Spalding Town Centre from the south. Approximately 1 kilometre south of the site access, the B1172 joins the A1175 which provides a connection to Stamford and to the A16 which provides a connection to Peterborough.
- 2.6 The key pedestrian desire line from the site is expected to be north towards the Little London area which provides amenities such as shops, hairdresser, takeaway and a post office. As shown in **Figure 2**, this is within a 2-kilometre/25-minute walk of the care home, which represents the 'preferred maximum' distance for commuting. The B1172 (Spalding Common) provides footways on at least one side of the carriageway which leads all the way to the Little London area.
- 2.7 It is generally accepted that up to 3 miles (or 5 kilometres) is an acceptable distance for cycle journeys. Therefore, **Figure 3** shows a 5-kilometre cycle catchment area from the site (representing approximately a 25-minute cycle). This demonstrates that areas including Deeping St Nicholas, Cowbit, Pode Hole, Little London and Spalding could be accessed by bicycle.
- 2.8 National Cycle Route 12 follows Cradge Bank which runs parallel to B1172 (Spalding Common) and can be accessed by heading north along the B1172 (Spalding Common) and turning east along The Ramper. This National Cycle Route connects Spalding to Peterborough via Crowland. **Figure 4** shows the cycle routes in the vicinity of the site as taken from [www.cycle.travel/city/spalding/map](http://www.cycle.travel/city/spalding/map).
- 2.9 **Figure 5** illustrates the closest bus stops to the site, which are at the 'Community Centre' and located approximately 400 metres north of Ashwood Care Home. These comprise bus stop signs including travel information, with the northbound stop also providing a shelter. Further bus stops at 'Stennett Avenue' are located approximately 550 metres south of the Care Home. All these stops are served by Route Number 37 operated by Stagecoach East and Route Numbers 301 and 302 operated by Delaine Buses.




2.10 **Table 1** contains a summary of the routes that would be served from these bus stops. It demonstrates that Bus Route Number 37 offers a combined total of 4 two-way services during peak periods. An hourly service is provided in both directions outside of peak hours and on Saturdays, along with 5 services operating on a Sunday. This route connects the site to key locations including Peterborough, Newark and Spalding. Bus Route Number 301 offers a combined total of 3 two-way services during peak periods. Again, an hourly service is provided in both directions outside of peak hours and on Saturdays. This route operates between Spalding and Stamford.

2.11 The nearest train station is Spalding Railway Station which is located approximately 3.7 kilometres northeast of the site. According to Google Maps Route Planning Tool, it can be accessed by a 14-minute cycle or an 8-minute car journey. It can also be accessed by a 10-minute bus journey from the 'Community Centre' bus stop.

2.12 The station is served by East Midlands Railway and connects Spalding to key locations including Doncaster, Peterborough, Sleaford and Lincoln. Cycle parking is provided at the station and comprises 16 sheltered cycle spaces with CCTV.

2.13 The station also provides 52 car parking spaces which have a daily weekday parking charge of £5.00 and a daily rate of £2.50 on Saturdays and Sundays. Discounts are also offered such as weekly tickets (priced at £15) and monthly tickets (priced at £50). 2.14 A review of Personal Injury Accident records has also demonstrated how there is no evidence of any ongoing safety problems within the immediate highway network. An extract of the [crashmap.co.uk](http://crashmap.co.uk) website showing this is provided below at **Image 2.14**.





### 3.0 TRAVEL SURVEY

3.1 Following on from the generic assessment of trip generation characteristics set out within Section 2 of this Travel Plan, a detailed staff and visitor travel survey was undertaken at the existing care home during March/April 2025. Copies of the corresponding survey sheets are provided at **Appendix A** of this Travel Plan. The staff travel survey was carried out over a two-week period where completed forms were collected from staff members. The visitor survey was overseen by reception where all visitors were asked to complete the form on arrival at the care home.

#### ***Visitor Travel Survey results***

3.2 Overall 44 visitor responses were provided during the survey period (spanning 24 to 27 March 2025 inclusive). Of these, 16 were recorded on the 24<sup>th</sup>, 14 on the 15<sup>th</sup>, 4 on the 27<sup>th</sup>, and 10 were undated. Hence, it is evident that the existing 47 bed care home generates up to 16 visitors per day, which could increase to 22 visitors with the increased number of bed spaces.

3.3 Question 1 of the survey sought to establish the gender of visitors at the site. **Image 3.3** below summarises the results and confirms that 29 of respondents were female (66%) and 15 were male (34%).


#### **Q1. Gender?**

3.4 Question 3 sought to identify the age range of visitors to the care home, and the responses are summarised below at **Image 3.4**. This shows that 34 of the 44 responses were older than 55 years old (77%), with the most responses coming from the 55 to 64 year old bracket (14 responses or 32% overall). Interestingly, there were no responses from visitors younger than 25 years old and only 2 from the 25 to 34 years bracket (5% overall).



3.5 Question 4 asked visitors about their time of arrival at the site and the responses are summarised in **Image 3.5** below. This shows that the majority of visitors arrive outside of the typical network peak periods and predominantly between 1100 and 1500 hours, with 32 of the 41 responses (78%). The busiest period for visitors was between 1100 and 1200 hours with 13 of the 41 responses (32% overall).

3.6 Question 5 sought to establish the extent of visitors with health issues or medical conditions that might affect travel requirements. The results are summarised in **Image 3.6** below and demonstrate how 41 of the 44 responses confirmed they had no material medical conditions (93% overall).



3.7 Question 6 asked visitors how they arrived at the care home that day and the responses are summarised below in **Image 3.7**. The results show that 33 of the 44 responses confirmed they arrived by car on their own (75% overall), with 5 responses arriving by car accompanied (11% overall). Interestingly, no visitors walked or cycled to the site and only a single visitor arrived by bus (2% overall).

**Q6. How did you get here?**



3.8 Following on from the above, Question 7 asked visitors how they would get home. The results are summarised below in **Image 3.8** and show a very similar pattern to Question 6, except that people that got a taxi to the care home perhaps sought to use the bus or another mode in getting home.




Q7. How will you get home?

3.9 Question 8 sought to identify where visitors might consider alternative modes of travel for their journeys to the care home. The results are summarised in **Image 3.9** and show 'car – accompanied' and 'taxi' as the standout options, with 14 and 10 responses respectively (or 35% and 25% overall). Travel by bus or walking formed the second and smaller group, each with 4 responses or 10% of the overall responses.


Q8. Alternative mode?

3.10 Question 9 sought to summarise how far visitors travelled in their journey to the care home and the responses are presented in **Image 3.10** below. They show a relatively even split between each of the categories from 1 to 20 miles, albeit with most journeys being between 10 and 20 miles (12 of the 43 responses, or 28%). There were a small number of journeys beyond the 20 miles threshold (3 of the 43 responses or 7%).


**Q9. Distance travelled?**

3.11 Question 10 asked visitors about the length of their journey in respect of timings. The responses are summarised in **Image 3.11** below and confirm that most of the visitors' journey times was between 0 and 15 minutes, with 19 of the 44 responses (43% overall). Following this, the next category of 16 to 30 minutes provided 14 of the 44 responses (32% overall).


Q10. How long was your journey?

3.12 To assess visitors' propensity to using alternative modes Question 11 asked what measures would encourage them to use public transport. The results are summarised in **Image 3.12** below and show the key response was 'none' with 19 of the 40 responses (48% overall). The second highest response was in the 'other' category which on inspection comprised a combination of more direct bus services and improved infrastructure, with 11 of the 40 responses (28% overall).

Q11. What would encourage you to use public transport?





3.13 Questions 12 and 13 sought to understand if visitors were experiencing problems or delays when parking at the care home. Question 12 asked visitors where they had parked and 39 of the 40 responses (98%) confirmed this was within the care home car park. This is backed up by the responses to Question 13, which asked how long it took them to park their vehicle. The results here confirmed that 16 of the 17 responses (94%) parked within 2 minutes of arriving at the site, indicating that there is no specific parking problem at the care home.

### ***Staff Travel Survey results***

3.14 The current care home operation employs 26 full-time and 8 part-time staff, which would increase by 6 full-time and 4 part-time staff within the extended operations. All other aspects of the site operation, in terms of opening hours etc will remain as per the existing care home. The staff travel survey collected 31 responses, or 91% of the existing staffing levels.

3.15 Question 2 of the staff travel survey sought to understand the spread of job roles at the care home. The responses are summarised in **Image 3.15** below and show three core areas, namely 'care related' staff (77%), 'housekeeping' staff (13%) and 'admin/management' staff (10%).



3.16 The range of staff ages were identified within Question 3, as summarised in **Image 3.16** below. The responses show that the majority of staff fall within the '35 to 44

years' category with 13 of the 31 responses (42% overall), although there is a general spread across all ages.

Q3. Age?




- Under 25 years    25 to 34 years   ■ 35 to 44 years

3.17 Question 4 sought to understand any pattern of staff medical issues that could affect travel to the care home. The results showed that 29 of the 31 responses (94%) did not consider they had any material medical conditions.

3.18 Question 5 sought to establish current working practices at the care home. Of the 30 responses, 9 stated they work 'out of hours' (30%) with only 3 stating 'normal working hours' (10%). The remaining 18 responses stated 'other'. On inspection of the details it was clear that these responses comprised 12-hour shifts (14 of the total responses) and a variation on the part-time hours (4 of the total responses). The full set of responses are summarised below at **Image 3.18**.

### Q5. Working Hours?




■ 1 = out of hours      2 = normal working hours      ■ 3 = other

3.19 Following on from Question 5, Question 6 sought to understand the split of Full and Part Time staff at the care home. The results are presented below in **Image 3.19**, confirming 28 full-time staff and 3 part-time staff.

### Q6. Full or Part Time Employment?




■ Full Time      Part Time

3.20 Question 7 asked staff about their main mode of travel to work and the results are presented in **Image 3.20** below. This shows that 24 of the responses (77% overall) arrived by car on their own, which is 10% higher than the initial estimates provided within Section 2. Otherwise, the level of car sharing is at 13% compared to 4% in the initial assessment, whilst there are currently no walking or bus trips to work and only 3% cycle.

### Q7. Main mode of travel?




■ bus ■ bicycle ■ car - on your own ■ car - accompanied ■ motorbike ■ walk ■ other

3.21 Question 8 sought to identify staff propensity to switch to an alternative mode of travel and the results are summarised in **Image 3.21** below. The results show how the car continues to represent the primary modal choice, although it is evident that cycling, bus, and accompanied car journeys could potentially provide good alternative options.

■ bus ■ bicycle ■ car - on your own ■ car - accompanied ■ motorbike ■ walk ■ other



3.22 Details of the distances travelled were provided within the responses to Question 9, as summarised below at **Image 3.22**. This confirms how 24 of the 31 responses live



within 4 miles of the care home (77% overall), which would be a comfortable cycling distance.

**Q9. Distance travelled?**




- up to 1 mile

3.23 Following on from Question 9, Question 10 seeks to understand the distances travelled by staff in their journeys to work. The results are summarised in **Image 3.23** below and show how 25 of the 31 responses (81%) live within a 15 minutes journey of the site, with all staff living within a 60 minutes journey time.

3.24 Question 11 explores what changes might encourage cycling for staff at the care home. The responses are summarised in **Image 3.24** below and show improvements to cycle infrastructure and discounted cycle purchase were significant factors. However, 17 of the 31 responses (55%) stated 'other', which on closer

examination comprised 8 responses stating there was 'nothing' that would encourage them and 9 responses requiring a more coordinated set of measures, including improved on-site facilities.

### Q11. What changes might encourage cycling?




3.25 Similar to Question 11, Question 12 seeks to understand what changes could be made to encourage increased access by public transport. The results are summarised in **Image 3.25** where 8 of the responses stated there was nothing that could be done to encourage public transport use (26%). However, 17 of the 31 responses (55%) stated that there were 'other' measures for consideration and this included a range of combined measures (i.e. improvements covering multiple areas rather than any single measure).

#### Q12. What changes might encourage public transport?





3.26 Question 13 seeks to understand the main reasons for using the car with the key response being a 'lack of any alternative' with 13 of the 31 responses (42%). Other standout responses were that the 'car was essential to perform job' (6 of 31 responses) and childcare related issues (also 6 of 31 responses). The results are summarised in **Image 3.26** below.



3.27 Question 14 asked staff where they parked their cars, with 26 of the 30 responses confirming they park within the workplace car park (87%). Of the remaining 4 responses, three were dropped off whilst one parked in the adjacent street.

3.28 Question 15 then asked about whether they would be prepared to car-share, with the results summarised below in **Image 3.28**. This shows that 21 of the 30 responses (70%) would be prepared to car share.



Q15. Prepared to car share?




■ 1 – yes    2 – No    ■ 3 – if no why

3.29 Following on from Question 15, Question 16 sought to understand what measure might encourage staff to car share. Despite the strong indication of staff being prepared to car share, the responses here confirmed 11 of the 29 responses (38%) considered there was nothing that could be done. However, 11 of the remaining responses (38%) also confirmed that help in finding car share partners would help them. The results are summarised below in **Image 3.29**.

### **Future Surveys**

3.30 In accordance with the highway authority's published guidance notes, the details of any subsequent staff and visitor travel surveys will be undertaken within three



months of first occupation or 25% occupancy (i.e. 5 of the new bed spaces being occupied). The final details of the surveys will be agreed with the highway authority using its MODESHIFT STARS travel planning system. The surveys will seek to deliver a minimum response rate of 50% for all staff and visitors.

- 3.31 Based on the results of these annual travel surveys the modal split profile will be recalculated to establish where the targets of the Travel Plan have been met and identify where further investment is required to address specific issues. The results will be submitted to the highway authority for discussion and agreement as part of an annual monitoring report.
- 3.32 All surveys will be scheduled to take place between March and October in each year (outside of any public/school holidays) to best represent neutral conditions.



## 4.0 OUTCOME OBJECTIVES

4.1 The overall objective of this Travel Plan is to ensure opportunities for sustainable travel at the site are maximised. This will be realised by a series of specific objectives that will form the basis of the Travel Plan process. These are summarised below in **Table 4.1**:

**Table 4.1 – Travel Plan Objectives**

Objective Number	Description
OBJ 1	Minimise single occupancy car trips to and from the site by staff and visitors.
OBJ 2	Work with staff and visitors to identify where opportunities for walking, cycling, and public transport can be adopted in preference to single occupancy car travel.
OBJ 3	Liaise with the council to identify where existing barriers to sustainable travel can be overcome for staff and visitor travel.
OBJ 4	Incorporate good practice within the site management to ensure all users are clear that maximising sustainable travel is a priority.

4.2 The above objectives have been identified in recognition of the potential overall activity, where staff will often work shift patterns and visitors to the site will predominantly occur during off-peak times at irregular intervals.



## 5.0 TARGETS AND INDICATORS

5.1 Targets are the measurable goals by which the performance of the Travel Plan and its implementation will be assessed. They are essential for monitoring the progress and success of the Travel Plan and should be SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic and Time-related).

5.2 To achieve measurable outputs from the Travel Plan process, it is important to establish targets from the outset, against which progress can be measured. The initial targets will be based on the staff and visitor daily travel survey results, which are summarised below.

5.3 It is important to note that there could be a high degree of variability in the annual results due to changeover of staff and visitors and their corresponding travel demands. However, in accordance with the council's published guidance the Travel Plan will actively seek to ensure that sustainable travel behaviour is established early on, with initiatives in place from the day of opening.

### ***Modal Split***

5.4 Given the relatively remote location and type of development the key target of this Travel Plan should be to deliver a 10% reduction in the amount of single occupancy car travel, or an overall split of 67.5% for visitors and 69.3% for staff. For the



purposes of an interim indicative assessment, if the care home was to generate 100 two-way daily person trips by staff (or 50 people visit the site each day by any given mode) then the 7.7% reduction from 77% to 69.3% would equate to 8 people switching from single occupancy car travel each day ( $100 \times 0.077$ ).

5.5 **Table 5.3** below sets out the first-year modal shift targets for STAFF trips.

5.6 The table above sets out how the 10% reduction (7.7% overall) in single occupancy staff car travel will be targeted towards a 3% increase in pedestrian travel (1.0% to 4.0%), a 1% increase in motorcycle trips (0% to 1%), a 3.5% increase in cycling (3.0% to 6.5%) and a 3.2% increase in car sharing/as passengers (13.0% to 16.2%), alongside a 3% reduction in the 'other modes'.

5.7 Based on the above example of 100 staff visiting the care home daily, this would equate to a single motorcyclist, 5 car sharers, 4 cyclists, and 6 pedestrians, with a corresponding reduction of 16 single occupancy car users.



5.8 Similarly, **Table 5.8** below sets out the first-year modal shift targets for VISITOR trips.

5.9 The table above sets out how the 10% reduction (7.5% overall) in single occupancy staff car travel will be targeted towards a 1.5% increase in pedestrian travel (1.0% to 2.5%), a 1% increase in motorcycle trips (0% to 1%), a 3.0% increase in cycling (0.0% to 3.0%) and a 5.0% increase in car sharing/as passengers (11.0% to 16.0%), alongside a 4% reduction in the 'other modes'.



## 6.0 MANAGEMENT STRATEGY

- 6.1 The purpose of the overall Travel Plan process is not to make it more difficult for people to drive, but to encourage non-essential single occupancy car users to adopt a more appropriate mode of travel. At this stage in the Travel Plan process, the key focus will be on reducing the need for car travel through softer measures for staff and visitors.
- 6.2 To ensure consistency across the Travel Plan period, Country Court Care Homes will appoint a Travel Plan Coordinator (TPC) within 3 months of receiving formal approval/agreement with the highway authority. If at any point the appointment of the Travel Plan Coordinator is changed, updated contact details will be communicated directly to the highway authority for their records. The TPC role will exist throughout the entire period of the Travel Plan to oversee the roll-out of each stage in its process, i.e. this Travel Plan and all subsequent Monitoring Reports (including the coordination of any surveys).
- 6.3 The TPC will undertake the following tasks:
  - Implement and promote the Travel Plan to staff and visitors.
  - Monitor the success of the Travel Plan, by reviewing the Monitoring Report and survey at the Detailed Travel Plan stage.
  - Liaise with public transport operators and members of the Council to improve the opportunities for sustainable travel, including organising any taster public transport tickets (or equivalent cycle voucher) for initial residents at the site.
  - Communicate details of relevant local cycle training and cycle maintenance opportunities to residents and visitors, alongside the organisation of any potential on-site events (subject to demand).
  - Be the point of contact for any queries associated with the Travel Plan both for senior board management at Country Court Care Homes alongside site-based staff and visitors.
- 6.4 Until such time as this Travel Plan is agreed with the highway authority and Country Court Care Homes has appointed a TPC role, the initial contact details are as follows:

## 7.0 MEASURES

7.1 **Table 7.1** below gives a summary of all key measures that will be introduced as part of this Travel Plan. They have been derived from the details contained in both the highway authority's published Travel Plan guidance along with the Governments 'Guidance for the Preparation of Travel Plans in support of Planning Applications' document and have been selected where they could have a positive effect in shifting the modal split away from single occupancy car travel. Further detailed description is provided below.

### ***Walking Incentives***

7.2 There are a variety of initiatives and incentives which the TPC could look at to achieve the target increases in walking trips for staff and visitors. Existing residents are already encourage to take outdoor walks where weather conditions are suitable. This comprises a member of staff accompanying each resident to ensure their safety.

7.3 The TPC will ensure that suitable active gear is available for emergencies. This will be stored in either a clear location near the front door or in reception and will be free to use for any employees. Some examples of active gear that could be provided would be umbrellas, waterproof jackets, gloves, wellies, sunglasses or sunhats.

7.4 The TPC will also liaise with local outdoor stores to establish whether employees could be offered discounted vouchers for purchasing walking equipment. These vouchers could be used towards the purchasing of items such as walking boots/trainers and waterproof jackets/trousers. The TPC will also promote national and regional walking events including Walk to Work week. These events will also be promoted on the travel notice board.

### ***Cycling Incentives***

7.5 There are a variety of initiatives and incentives which the TPC could look at to achieve the desired increase in cycle travel for staff and visitors. The Government's 'Cycle to Work' initiative allows employees to purchase bikes and cycle equipment tax-free through their employer, which provides a significant reduction in the overall cost to the employee for these purchases. The TPC will promote the initiative to care home staff and assist with any form completion.

7.6 In addition, the TPC will liaise with local cycle stores to establish whether staff could be offered discounted vouchers for the purchasing of cycle equipment. These vouchers could be used towards the purchasing of a new bike or equipment such as helmets, lights or clothing. Furthermore, discounts could also be offered to employees for bicycle repairs and/or servicing.



7.7 The TPC will promote national and regional cycling events including National Bike Week and Cycle to Work Day. These events will also be promoted on the travel notice board.

### ***Bus Incentives***

7.8 To achieve the required increase in bus travel for staff and visitors, the TPC will liaise with the local bus operator to establish whether tickets could be offered to staff as free tasters or at a discounted price for a set period. This could encourage staff to change their travel behaviours at an early stage of employment with the intention that they continue to do so after the free/discounted pass expires. The TPC will also provide staff with further information on seasonal passes which could encourage them to purchase a longer-term ticket.

7.9 The TPC will also promote the nationwide free bus travel scheme for eligible and mobile residents. This can be applied for online, or by phone. The annual travel surveys will also explore whether the timing of shifts presents a barrier to bus travel at the site with consideration given to adjusting these as required.

### ***Car share scheme***

7.10 The TPC will look to set up a car-sharing scheme within the care home. This would provide a platform for staff to share details to find others travelling from a similar area and car-share with them and therefore help to achieve the required increase in car sharing for both staff and visitors.

7.11 The TPC will also encourage staff and visitors to sign up for the Liftshare database. The website contains details on various car journeys that are planned by its users across the country, allowing other users to identify opportunities to car share. All staff who drive will be encouraged to register for free on the database. By signing up to the database, they will be given login details with which they can access the journeys of other users, to see if there is potential for car sharing.



## 8.0 MARKETING STRATEGY

8.1 The TPC's role within this Travel Plan for the care home will include a series of tasks that shall:

- Implement and promote the Travel Plan for the care home once fully operational.
- Monitor the Travel Plan (via the arrangement of the collection and collation of appropriate data).
- Give advice and information on transport-related subjects to staff and visitors.
- Liaise with third parties (i.e. public transport operators, the Council) on Travel Plan issues.

8.2 Travel Packs will be produced prior to occupation and distributed to each employee upon enrolment. Details of the Travel Pack will be agreed upon with the Highway Authority prior to distribution. The Travel Packs will comprise up-to-date sustainable transport information and several incentives to influence travel habits, including the following details.

- Details of all bus routes that operate in the vicinity of the site, along with maps showing local walking and cycle routes.
- Details of any developments in the vicinity which have implemented new bus routes/services or cycle/pedestrian infrastructure.
- Details of any opportunities for discounted bus tickets could be provided once this has been discussed with any local bus operators, for an initial period to try and incentivise people to use the local bus services.
- A summary of benefits that having a Travel Plan brings, to individuals, the community and the environment.
- Information on cycle safety.
- An initial feedback survey to gather early information about perceived transport choices. The survey will be followed up by the Travel Plan Coordinator with an offer of personalised travel planning.
- A copy of this Travel Plan and contact details for relevant organisations, such as the TPC, local taxi companies and any representatives from the sustainable travel team at Lincolnshire County Council.

8.3 The Travel Packs will also outline the benefits of travelling sustainably in terms of the positive outcomes to an individual's health along with the financial savings it



brings. Details of upcoming national sustainable travel events will also be detailed on the notice board. The following list identifies a number of (typically) national campaigns that could be publicised at the site to help promote sustainable travel:

- Walk to work day
- World environment day
- National Liftshare week
- Transport and Climate Change week
- Cycle to work week
- Bike to work day

8.4 Promotional material will also be provided, including details of any website addresses that may be useful, such as local initiatives aimed at getting people more active. They also contain a range of route planning tools to help locals complete the work commute via a different mode of travel, whether that is for walking, cycling or public transport. Useful websites include the following:

## 9.0 MONITORING AND REVIEW

- 9.1 In accordance with the highway authority's published guidance, staff and visitor travel patterns will be monitored annually to understand where the targets are being met. Where the Travel Plan is not meeting its targets the auditing period will continue until this changes. In accordance with the requirements of the planning condition, this will be continuous during the lifetime of the care home.
- 9.2 Details of all future staff and visitor travel surveys will be agreed in advance between the TPC and representatives of Lincolnshire County Council's sustainable travel team. This will include the use of MODESHIFT STARS as appropriate.
- 9.3 Separate surveys will be undertaken for each user group (staff or visitors) with the aim of establishing existing travel patterns alongside any propensity to change mode. As stated above, the surveys will be undertaken during neutral months to ensure the data is representative. It will be the responsibility of the TPC to organise and analyse the surveys.
- 9.4 Following completion of the surveys the TPC will prepare an annual Monitoring Report for submission to the highway authority for agreement. This will include a detailed summary of the findings and review how the past years targets have or have not been met. Accordingly, it will also provide an opportunity for reviewing the suitability of ongoing targets for the coming year. The completed Monitoring Report will be submitted to the highway authority within one month of the surveys being completed.



## 10.0 ACTION PLAN AND BUDGET

10.1 This section of the Travel Plan details the anticipated programme and timescales for the ongoing development of the Travel Plan. This action plan, as summarised in **Table 10.1** below, outlines how the key elements will be brought together.
