I just wanted to confirm that LWT will be maintaining the holding objection on this application as many of our concerns have not been addressed.

A ecological survey is relevant for approximately 18 months, this survey is from 2021. The habitat has likely changed.

The BNG metric has been provided (though presumably using the out-of-date surveys), but none of the compulsory 30 year management and monitoring plans.

And lastly, no bat survey can be found.
