

Teen in court over attempted murder

A 16-year-old boy who was allegedly left for dead after a violent assault in Holbeach had no idea why he was attacked, a court heard this week.

Another youth aged 16 denies a charge of attempted murder after the boy was found with wounds to his throat and chest.

His injuries were so severe he needed to be put into an induced coma, the jury at Lincoln Crown Court was told.

The teenager accused of attempted murder cannot be named for legal reasons.

He has also been charged with wounding the boy with intent to cause him grievous bodily harm.

The defendant has already pleaded guilty to the lesser offence of unlawful wounding.

"He has accepted he was the person who carried out the attack and he has accepted he wounded the victim,"

said Stuart Lody, prosecuting. He added that police officers who arrived at the scene 'heard a noise which sounded like the howl of a dog.'

The officers saw blood and were concerned for the boy.

The victim was found on land adjacent to the William Stukeley Primary School, laying face down with a scooter put on top.

The jury was told the defendant had made a Face-time call to a teenage girl during the early hours of July 28.

During the call, the victim could be seen lying on the ground while the defendant could be seen holding an unbroken beer bottle.

It is alleged the defendant had already made a threat to slit the throat of the victim and told the girl "his future is in your hands."

A short time later, at 1.22am, it is alleged the girl received a second message which said 'it's on you.'

Mr Lody told the court that police officers saw the victim was face down and a scooter had been placed on top of him.



An ambulance took the teenager to the Queen's Medical Centre in Nottingham where he was placed in an induced coma.

The victim was later interviewed by police officers and the video was played to members of the jury.

He explained that he had drunk a quarter of a bottle of vodka and had no memory of the assault.

He said the last memory

was going to a red bench with the other youth and a teenage girl who he recalled was crying.

His next memory was waking up in hospital, members of the jury were told.

When he was asked if he could think of any reason for the assault, the boy said he had 'no idea.'

"I didn't feel threatened or anything," he said.

Mr Lody told jurors that

during the trial, which was expected to last for five days, they would be hearing evidence from witnesses who recalled the defendant 'ranting and raving' while talking to someone called 'Adrian' who was someone in his head.

The trial Judge Simon Hirst told the jury: "Your job is to decide if the defendant is guilty or not guilty of the charges read out to you."
